



CICA BAUMA 2010 TOUR

This is the sixth consecutive CICA Bauma Tour that we have arranged, and like those before, promises new locations and visits not incorporated before. This has been achieved by careful research and also to a large degree, drawing on the organizing group's personal experience in travelling to the respective locations. We continue to have a healthy number of Factory visits and a great deal of gratitude is extended to all Manufacturers who have supported us for all six tours. Rachelle Regan of the Departure Lounge will be our logistical provider for air-fares and ground movements in Europe.

Preference will be given to CICA/State Association Members for a place on the Tour or Accommodation in Munich. Rachelle does not control this function so please don't try to "buck" the system by going direct to Rachelle to secure a seat in the bus or a room in Munich.

The Bus component of the Tour commences on Monday April 12, 2010 so the arrival into Amsterdam can be varied to suit the individual's requirements. The total number of seats for the Bus Tour is limited to a maximum of 50. The first few Days in the following Itinerary are our idea of the ideal arrangements to get to know and enjoy Amsterdam.

We have provided web page details for those who wish to be better informed about where they are going and what they can expect to see. This is especially important for the Villers-Brettonneux visit which is really a more significant memorial in a lot of respects than that at Gallipoli.

For those using the Accommodation that CICA have arranged in Munich please note that there is no negotiations on the length of stay, which is 5 Days. The Hotel will not accept anything less. CICA does not profit from the Tour, the service is provided as an extension of its overall commitment to the Crane Industry in Australia. The choice of Hotels was dictated by the 2007 Tour Group who voted unanimously to stay in the centre of Munich. The increase in cost is a direct result of this decision.

The coach used on the Tour will have an English speaking driver and a toilet as well as the CICA Tour Leader.
