The significant hazards associated with operating cranes near overhead powerlines cannot be overstated.

Overhead powerlines carry extremely high-voltage electricity, and any contact between a crane and a powerline can result in severe injuries, fatalities, and damage to equipment.



Remaining vigilant and following strict safety guidelines is crucial for the prevention of accidents and ensuring the well-being of everyone involved.

The lookupandlive.com mapping application assists in lift planning.

This tool may help minimise contact and reduce the risk of injury or death from electrocution and damage to equipment and to the electricity network.



And the good news is that Victoria's overhead powerlines are now included.
